

Case Study New Build Detached Houses Whalley, Lancashire. Soundsure 560 | 5.6mm Underscreed Resilient Layer

Product Used: Sonixx Soundsure 560 Project Size: 1,220m² Supplier: Tekfloor Ltd.

The Project

Soundsure 560 was laid over concrete blocks (1350 kg/m³ from Lynx Precast), installed as an acoustic resilient layer below insulation, underfloor heating pipework and 75mm sand / cement screed. Installed in first floor areas of all 8 houses.

Soundsure 560 was overlaid with 30mm insulation, a waterproof membrane, and underfloor heating pipes clipped into place. A 75mm sand / cement screed was then laid above. Soundsure 560 was lapped up all perimeter edges, ensuring that the insulation and screed were isolated from the main structure, providing maximum acoustic performance.

- Exceeds the performance standards required in the UK building regulations for sound insulation.
- Ideal for use in New Build Houses, as well as Apartments and Hotels, where acoustic insulation is required.
